Laleham Lea School Pupils Support Purley Food Hub

Pupils from Laleham Lea School in Purley dropped off their Harvest Festival collection at Purley Food Hub this week to help support families in crisis.

Over 200 items including pasta, tinned vegetables, baby wipes and washing up liquid were donated by Laleham Lea families to the charity who are urgently requesting donations in the run up to the Christmas period.

Steve Hunt, Administrator for Purley Food Hub said: "Thank you so much for the Harvest food donation that we received from Laleham Lea – it was perfect timing!

"Last month was not only our busiest September since we opened in 2013 but also our second busiest month overall, with food for more than 2,500 meals provided to people in crisis. As a result, our stocks have become seriously low. "We urgently need to build them up again in the weeks leading to Christmas so the food and other items delivered this week have arrived at just the right time."

Ms Barry, Headteacher at Laleham Lea said: "We are delighted to be able to help the Food Hub with our Harvest Donation and I'd like to thank all our families and staff for their generosity.

"Our children are always keen to help those in need and we hope that this donation helps in some small way to support the fantastic work that the Food Hub does for the local community."
