Anaphylaxis Campaign

It is estimated that in the UK 5-8% of children have a proven food allergy. For many children, the symptoms of allergy are mild. However, occasionally the symptoms are severe and they may even be life-threatening. The common causes of severe allergic reactions (anaphylaxis) include foods such as peanuts, tree nuts, milk, eggs,

shellfish, fish, sesame seeds and kiwi fruit, although many other foods have been known to trigger anaphylaxis.

Katie, an Information Officer at the Anaphylaxis Campaign visited us on Tuesday to give an allergy awareness assembly to the pupils. During the assembly the children talked about common allergens, signs of a severe allergic reaction and what to do if they spot them, what situations might be more difficult for someone with an allergy, and things they can do to help their friends with allergies. This included not sharing their lunch or snacks, and simple measures to avoid cross contamination such as washing hands after eating.

Katie said 'I was delighted to visit Laleham Lea on Tuesday, it was fantastic to see how engaged the children were on the topic and that they already have a good awareness of allergies.'

We have children in school who have a severe allergy to peanuts and all nuts. Please do not send your child to school with any nuts for snack time or in their packed lunch, this also includes Nutella, peanut butter and any sauces (pesto) or biscuits/ cereal bars or that may contain nuts or nut spreads.




Drawing Club made the most of the great weather this week and took the opportunity to display some amazing botanical sketching skills.
