- Always verify an email payment request directly with the School Business Manager. Be alert to unexpected fee requests
- Do not attempt to verify the instruction by replying to the email or by making contact with any other phone number then 0208 660 3351.
- Be particularly vigilant when you are being asked to send payments to new or different bank accounts than those normally used by the school. Check for inconsistencies and grammatical errors in emails, such as a misspelt school name or a slightly different email address; these can be warning signs of fraud.
