## Laleham Lea School pupil celebrates more National ISA swimming success

Laleham Lea School pupil, and Croydon resident, Jamie Johnson is celebrating winning gold in the Year 6 50m backstroke at the Independent Schools Association Swimming Championships for the second year in a row.

The eleven-year-old swimmer secured the title last Sunday (January 21st) at the London Aquatics Centre at Queen Elizabeth Olympic Park in Stratford.

Over 300 schools took part in the national event, which also saw Jamie win silver medals in the Year 6 50m freestyle and the Year 6 200m medley relay.

Ms Cooper, Swimming Coach at Laleham Lea said: "We are absolutely delighted with Jamie's winning swim, especially because she was up against some of the strongest swimmers in the country. She has been training hard for this event and put in an incredible performance to win the title."
