The football squad went to the Margaret Roper Catholic Schools annual tournament on Saturday morning and a great morning it turned out to be.

The first game resulted in a 2-1 win with goals from Dylan and Rok before facing what looked like the two of the strongest sides in the whole tournament. Another 2-1 win against Thomas Becket in one of the games of the tournament with goals from Rok and Arron before defeating St Aidans 2-0 with Rok and Arron again on the scoresheet. Our last group game was a comfortable 2-0 win against St Mary's with Dylan scoring both goals.

This meant we were the only team in the tournament that ended the group stages with maximum points with 8 goals scored and 2 conceded.

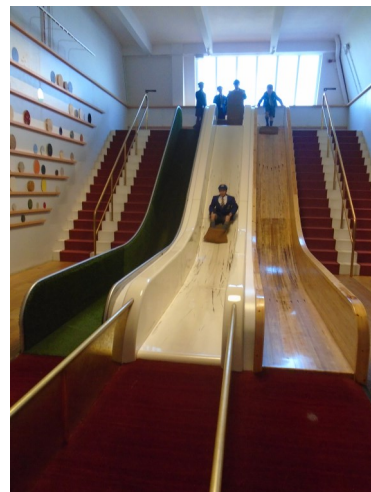
