We are absolutely delighted to announce the final total of our 'Give it up for Lent' CAFOD appeal. We raised £1191.71 – an incredible amount of money for a small school like ours! The Government has pledged to



double whatever schools raise, so that means we will be sending off nearly £2400 to help families living in poverty in countries such as Zimbabwe. We have invited a representative from CAFOD to come and explain to the children exactly what their money will be used for, but projects include: buying seeds and tools so that families can grow their own crops; providing training and support for vegetable-growing; providing fresh water supplies, toilets and solar panels. All these things will greatly improve the quality of these families' lives.

The children really embraced the challenge; some gave up sweets or chocolate and donated the money they would have spent on those things; some organised sponsored events and some of the children were incredibly generous in donating large amounts of their own money to help others. We feel really proud of them for their efforts.

Thank you to everyone: Pupils, Parents, Staff and Governors for your support with this initiative.
