

This week in Nursery

Nursery visited the Science Room this week during British Science Week to look at the materials used to construct bridges. The children discussed the story of 'The Three Billy Goat's Gruff' and answered questions about the story. They used varied language such as 'big', 'strong', 'weak', 'wood', 'iron', 'gaps', and 'safe'. The children recalled the bridges they have seen in real life including Tower Bridge and London Bridge.



Using various materials including Lego, Jamanga bricks and lollipop sticks the children had a wonderful time exploring and discovering through building and active learning.



Nursery have also been looking at 'Slippery slopes' using various liquids travelling down ramps as well as exploring propulsion, using balloons to demonstrate the forces of push and pull and the effect of air pressure.
