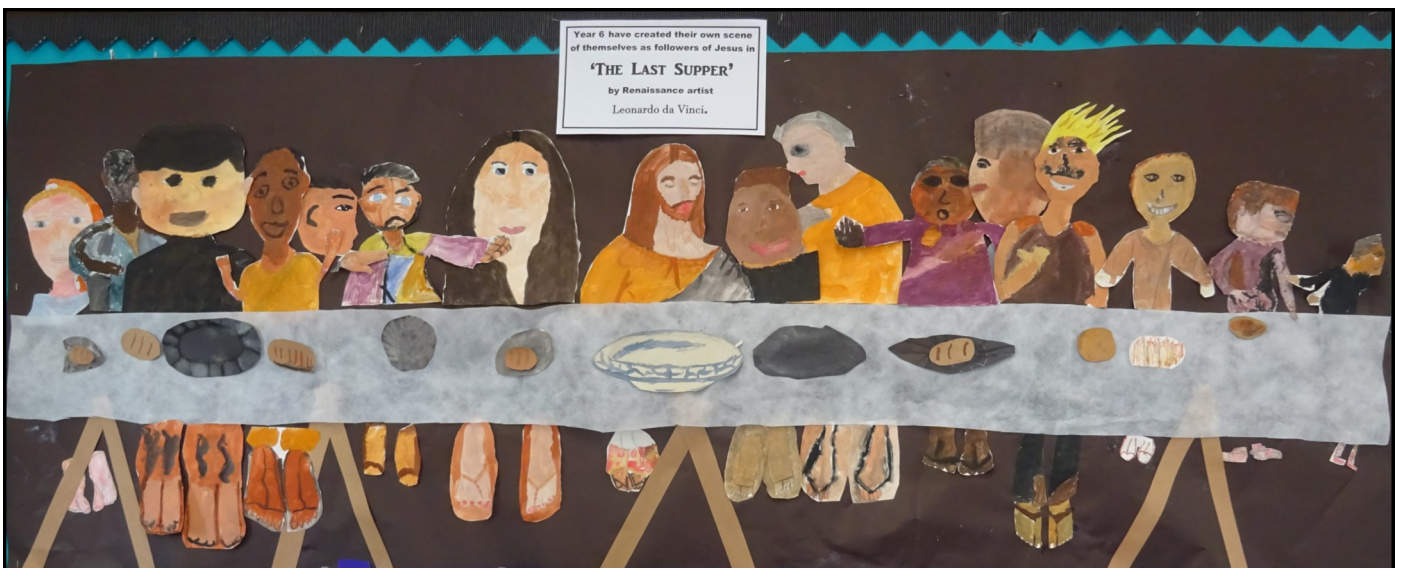
Wishing you all a peaceful and restful Easter with your families.
