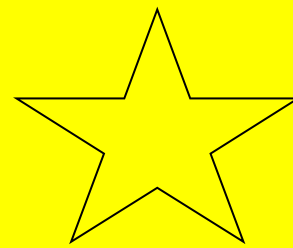
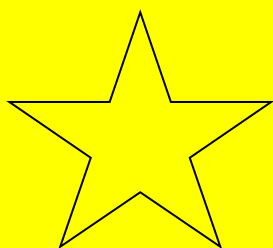
Our School Council representative have also been elected and we wish them every success with their roles.
