Our Peri Teachers do still have some vacancies. If you would like your child to learn an instrument, please contact the School Office for more information.

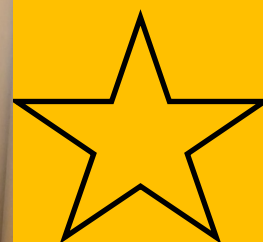
Our lunchtime and after school clubs have started again this week. There are still some spaces left in some clubs (some of which are free of charge). Please do contact the School Office for booking information.
