Let us remember, that as many hands build a house, many hearts make a school.

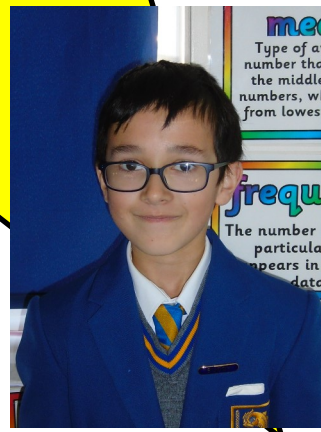

## Nursery News

### Ms Hogsden

This week Nursery are looking at the topic of 'Hibernation'.

The children watched a short video about animals that hibernate and why they do this. The children also enjoyed participating in activities to support their knowledge and understanding, including:



- Using different coloured paints to paint a picture of their own chosen animal and discuss what it is and its environment.
- Nursery also listened to a story this week called 'Don't Hog the Hedge' and discussed the story and its characters.
- Following on from this, the children then categorised pictures of animals into groups of whether they hibernate or not.
- The children have been creative this week and used different media and materials such as playdough, recycled materials, glitter and small sticks to create their own animal dens for hibernation.
