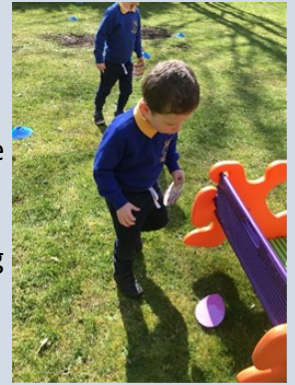

- Using 2D shapes to create an Easter chick.



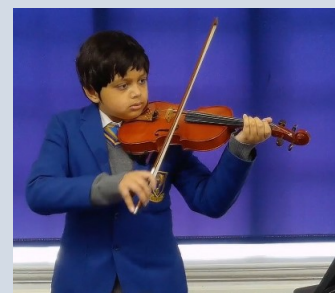
Virtual Easter Concert

Year 2 made some lovely colourful Easter Baskets this week with Miss O'Brien



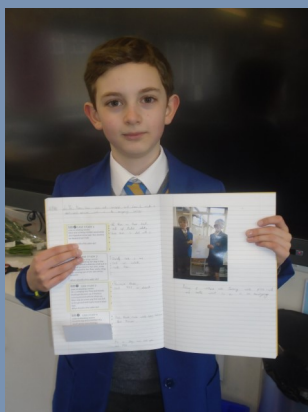
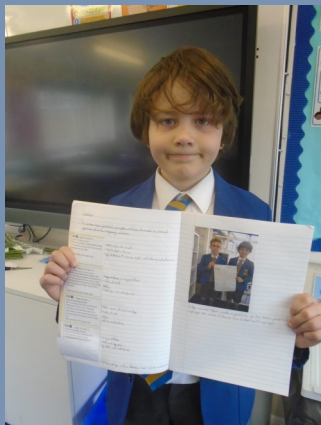
Year 1
