This week Nursery have been enjoying looking 'Easter' activities including:


- Listening to a story called 'Saving Easter'. They discussed the structure of the story and answered questions to reinforce their understanding.

### Year 1


Year 1 also made beautiful Easter Baskets and decorated them with foam stickers.
