Nursery News

This week Nursery have been exploring the topic 'Measurement'. We have been:

- point 'introducing Viewing а power measures'. We shared examples, reinforcing and introducing new mathematical language.
- Investigating Teddy's towers, we used the maths cubes to measure from the shortest to the tallest.
- Exploring the word 'Capacity', understanding that this is the amount that something holds.
- Investigating different sized containers in the water tray pouring water. In small groups, we looked at full, half-full and empty.
- Investigating some scales and different objects around the room, taking it in turns to measure them and discussing about 'Heavy' and 'Light' as an extension, we completed a reinforce sticking activity to our understanding visually.
