### Nursery

This week Nursery have been exploring the topic '3D Shapes'. The children have been participating in a range of activities to reinforce their understanding including:

- Listening to a story called 'Captain Vincible and the Space Shapes'
- Investigating 3D shapes by asking: 'Will it roll?', 'Will it slide?' and 'Will it stack?'
- Recording information about how many 3D shapes we can find.
- This week we have also been learning about Diwali and celebrating this festival by creating our own Diva candles, firework pictures and exploring Rangoli patterns.



### Year 1

Year 1 have been looking at patterns and rhyme in poetry. This week we looked the famous poems 'Old Mother Hubbard' and 'Pat a Cake Pat a Cake' using our hands to clap out the rhyme. We then modelled the actions for 'Two Little Dickie Birds'.



We discussed that these are traditional

rhymes from British culture, but other cultures have their own traditional rhymes. Children worked in pairs to reads a poem from another culture and focus on unfamiliar words and rhyming patterns. Children were challenged to give reasons for their favourites and which ones they enjoyed reading aloud the most.

# Reception

Reception Class have enjoyed learning all about Diwali this week making their own Rangoli patterns and lamps. Some Students have also brought in lots of items and books from home to share with their friends.

Year 2 have also created their own Rangoli patterns for Diwali as they learned all about Hinduism as part of RE this week.

This week we have been learning about Hinduism and the importance of Brahman in the Hindu faith along with the Holy Pilgrimages to the River Ganges.

Year 4 have thoroughly enjoyed learning about the story of Diwali. They wrote a heart- wrenching diary entry from the perspective of Sita, entrapped by the evil Ravana. They shared in with Diwali festivities; painting Diya lamps and dressing up in intricately embroidered traditional clothing, bursting with rich and bold colours of the East.
