Year 6




Year 6 have really been enjoying our 'Romeo and Juliet' theme. They have made some beautiful invitations to the Capulet Ball, written modern versions of the 'Balcony Scene' and compared different stage productions.

Nursery

This week nursery have been investigating the topic mixing colours. The children have been experimenting by completing different activities including:

- Completing a finger painting activity.
- Mixing two colours together to make a new colour and talking about how this colour was made.
- Listening to the story 'The Boy and the Rainbow' and as a class discussing the structure of the story and its characters, completing the story sequence activity to reinforce our understanding.
- Extension work using differentiation, attempting the Phase 2 initial sounds and colouring/pencil control activity based on the story.
- Participating in the 'Walking rainbow science experiment.' using extended vocabulary and open ended questions.
- Creating our own colour collage using a variety of materials.







This week Year 4 delved into the Amazonian Rainforest using their senses to write a stunning setting description. Mrs Khan was overwhelmed to see them employ literary devices with confidence to make the rainforest come alive!
