This week, children in Year 6 have been designing and creating First World War propaganda posters in Art. They have also been finding out about the role of animals in the war effort.



Nursery

This week Nursery have been focusing on stories. Each day this week, we have listened to a story and participated in a variety of activities to reinforce our knowledge further. This included a discussion and comprehension of each story, the structure and its characters. We have also been looking at the roles of an Author and an Illustrator. Activities have included:

- Listening to the story 'Room on the Broom' and answering questions to reinforce understanding. We also created our own magic wand using objects from the garden.
- Completing a Maths' activity and placing pictures of the characters from 'Room on the Broom' in the correct order of size. We extended our vocabulary using words such as big, large, medium sized, small and little.
- 'The Ginger Bread Man' we enjoyed completing a Science experiment and used prompt cards to introduce new vocabulary and questioning.
- 'Goldie- Locks and the Three Bears' in Spanish.
- Listening to the story 'Jack and the Beanstalk' we followed instructions to colour the correct amount of beans.
- Listening to the story 'The Three Little Pigs' and answering questions to reinforce knowledge of the story.
- Used a variety of materials to design our own house. Some of the things we discussed were—How could you make it stronger? Would the wolf be able to blow the house down?

Year 4 have been using the power of persuasion and rhetorical questions to write formal letters this week in English.

Our Maths focus this week has been about Comparing Lengths. The children went outside to find one leaf, they then found another that was shorter, and one that was longer than the first leaf. They arranged the three leaves in order and stuck them to a piece of paper. They labelled their leaves and

talked about which was the shortest and the longest.

Year 3 have had a lot of fun making their own Celtic Pot designs in Art this week.


Year 5


