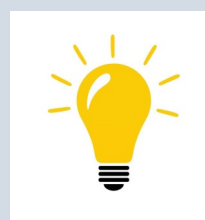

Laleham Lea School has almost completed its rolling LED lighting programme and the lights in the classrooms and communal areas are now all LED. LED lights are up to 80% more efficient than traditional lighting such as fluorescent and incandescent lights. 95% of the energy in LEDs is converted to light, so our classrooms are also brighter, and only 5% is wasted as heat.

We have also completed the double-glazing for all the windows and doors at the back of the school and plan to continue to the front of the school. Not only have we shielded our classrooms from cold weather but we will reduce our energy bills and reduce carbon dioxide emissions.

## Nursery

This week Nursery have continued the topic of 'Winter' and participated in lots of activities to support their learning including:

- Matching number and quantity of snowmen buttons.
- Listening to the story 'Jack Frost' and answering questions to reinforce our understanding and structure of the story.
- Participating in an ice melting experiment. Using extended vocabulary to discuss what happens, and learning about 'prediction'.
- Using a variety of mark making tools to design our own winter clothes and for differentiated work, attempting to complete the repeated pattern scarves.



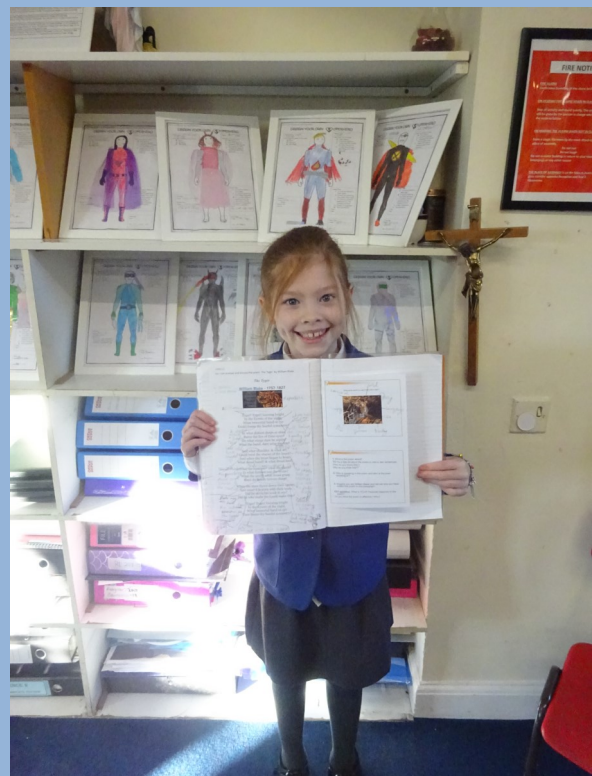
## Year 1

Year 5 have been looking at the NSPCC 'PANTS' campaign this week and discussing how to stay safe and who to talk to if they have any worries.

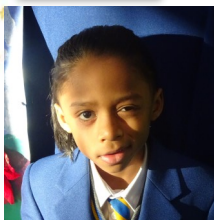


## Year 3

Year 3 are enjoying their History topic 'The Romans' and have created some lovely pieces of writing and Art work for their classroom display.

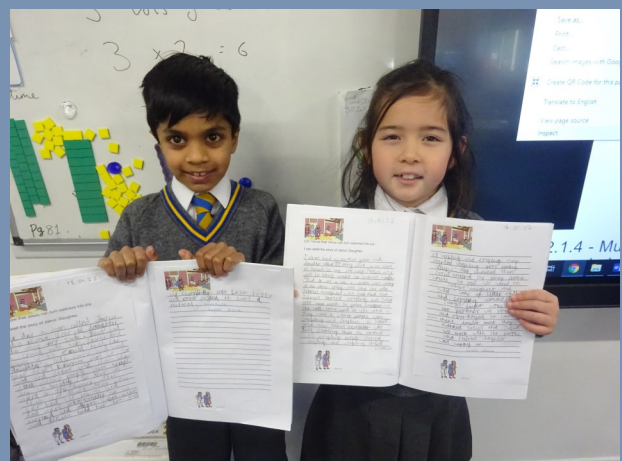

Year 2 have done some lovely writing this week in RE.

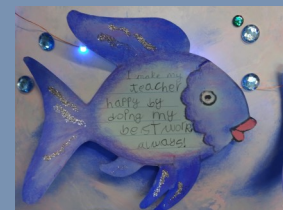
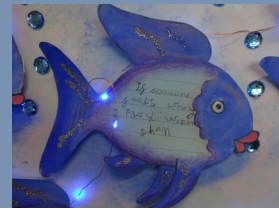




## Reception
