Safer Internet Day February 8th 2022

Each year in the UK, Safer Internet Day explores a new issue or theme which is impacting the lives of

young people in the UK.

By helping your child to feel confident and secure, they are more likely to share their ideas and opinions, ask questions, and contribute to discussions without fear of judgment or negative feedback.

Websites like Common Sense Media or The Family Gaming Database can be invaluable sources of information. When your child starts talking about a new game or app, why not do some research into the reporting and blocking options available? Then you can help your child if they come to you with an issue.

Let your child know that the best way to address any problem they have online, is to tell a trusted adult immediately. For example, this might include someone sending them a friend request; an online message; telling them to visit a specific website, or app; or asking them for their personal information. Reassure them that if anything happens online that they are unsure about, or makes them feel worried or upset, they can come to you for help.

All students at Laleham Lea are aware of the Role of the Designated Safeguarding Lead (DSL) and know who they can go to in school if they need help and support. Over the coming weeks students will be taking part in special Computing and PSHE lessons reinforcing the message of internet safety.
