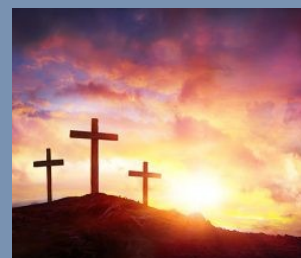

Inspired by 'the Last Supper' Year 6 painted their own self portraits in Art.



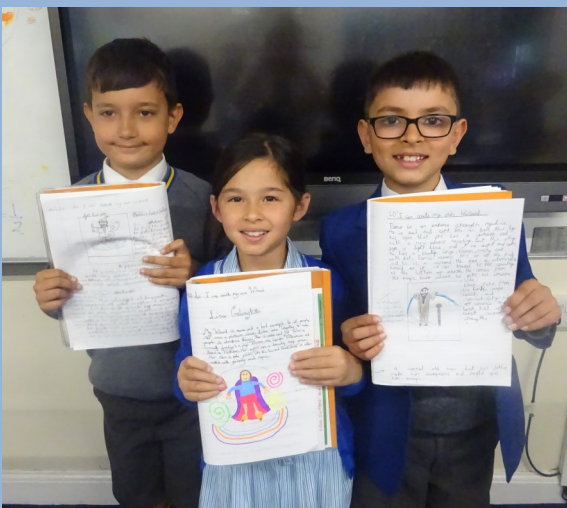
Year 2
