# Nursery

This week Nursery have been exploring the topic of 'Measurements'. This included:

- Viewing a power point introducing measures. We shared examples, reinforcing and introducing new mathematical language.
- Investigating 'Teddy's Towers', we used maths cubes to measure from the shortest to the tallest.
- Exploring the word 'capacity' understanding that this means the amount that something holds.
- Investigating different sized containers in the water tray pouring water.
- In small groups, we looked at full, half-full and empty.
- Investigating some scales and different objects around the room, taking it in turns to measure them and discussing 'heavy' and 'light' as an extension, we completed a sticking activity to reinforce our understanding.



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## Reception

This week we have been reading the story of 'Tell Me A Dragon'.

Reception Class created their own dragon world inspired by how Jackie Morris (the author and illustrator) drew the background in the story - paying close attention to the rolling hills and cities, complete with turrets, towers and castles.

Year 6 have been finding out about the work of Sir Alexander Fleming this week. They have written diary entries about his accidental discovery of penicillin. Through their writing, they have shown that Fleming hypothesised that the mould, or something in the mould, could kill bacteria. He needed to prove that it was in fact something in the mould which caused the reduced bacterial growth, and so the class designed an investigation to demonstrate this effect.
