Nursery

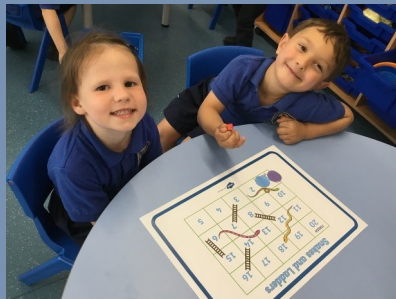
This week Nursery have been looking at the topic of 'Jungle Animals'. The children enjoyed participating in a range of activities to develop their knowledge further including:

Year 3



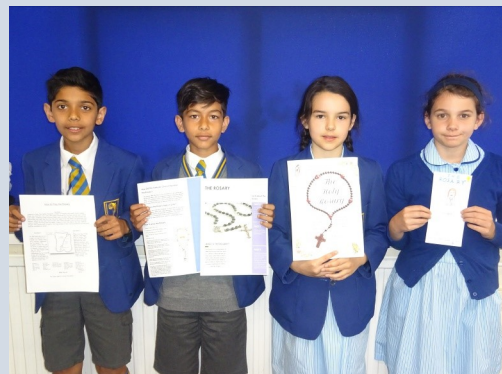
Year 3's exploration of Ancient Egypt continues with these detailed Canopic jars which were made in Art this week.

Year 4



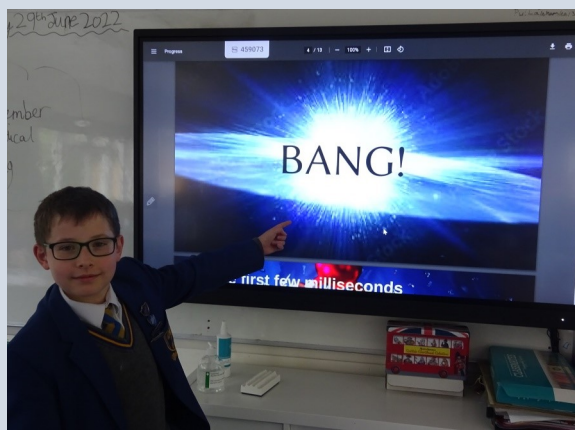
This week Year 4 have examined the Ancient Greek city states of Athens and Sparta, looking at the stark differences between the great cities.
