This week Nursery have been exploring the topic of 'Harvest'. The children have been discussing different fruits and vegetables and participating in the following activities:

- Using a number to help count the Harvest objects
- Using a variety of sticking materials to design our own scarecrow hat and discussing the textures used, such as 'shiny', 'smooth', 'bumpy', 'rough', 'hard', 'fluffy' and 'soft'.
- Completing a cutting and sticking activity and learning about repeated patterns.
- Using our senses to explore and investigate different vegetables using the tweezers, spoons and magnifying glasses in the sensory tray.
- Meeting our friend Jack the scarecrow and participating in a sticking activity to create our own scarecrow.
- Bringing in Harvest Gifts to help others.


