- Listening to the interactive story 'Mix it up'



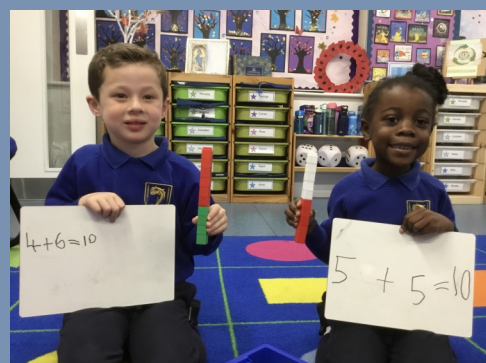
## Reception

Year 2 are enjoying their 'Great Fire of London' Topic and made these colourful pictures in their Art lesson.

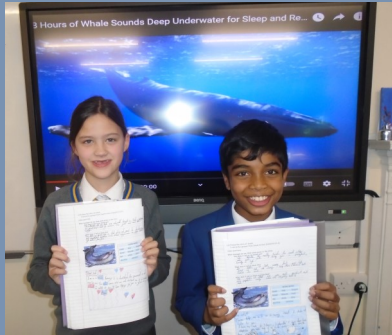
## Year 3
