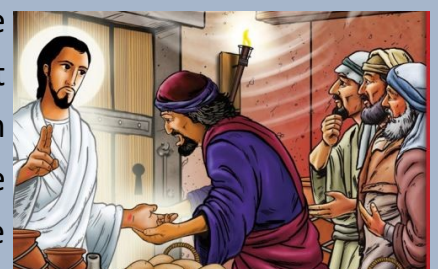
Wishing us all a relaxing and sunny half term.

Well done to all of Year 1 for completing their 'Tree Hunt' homework.

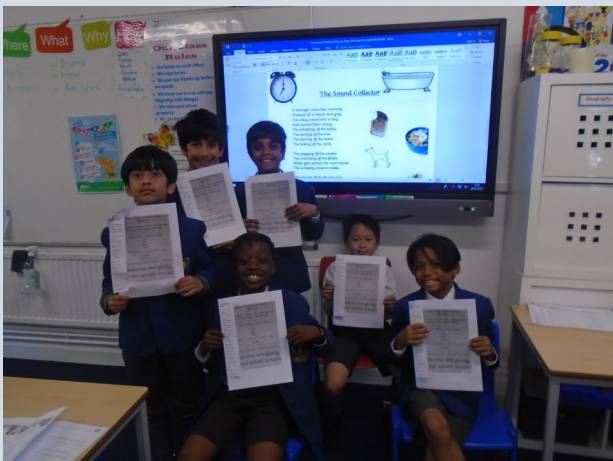
We had a wonderful time observing various leaves and identifying which tree they belong to.
