

Laleham Lea School Pupils Support St Vincent's Centre

The Mini Vinnies are the youngest members of the St Vincent de Paul Society (SVP), an international Christian voluntary organisation dedicated to tackling poverty in all its forms by providing practical assistance to people in need. Items including pasta, tinned vegetables, custard and washing pods were donated by Laleham Lea families to the St Vincent Centre who are urgently requesting donations during these challenging times for families.
